

How to save alarm picture or video to FTP

You need to have your own FTP serve. It can be local LAN network or based on Internet.
Please set FTP directory permission to 777 (**rw-rw-rw-**)

Files: Read / Write / Append / Rename / Delete / Execute

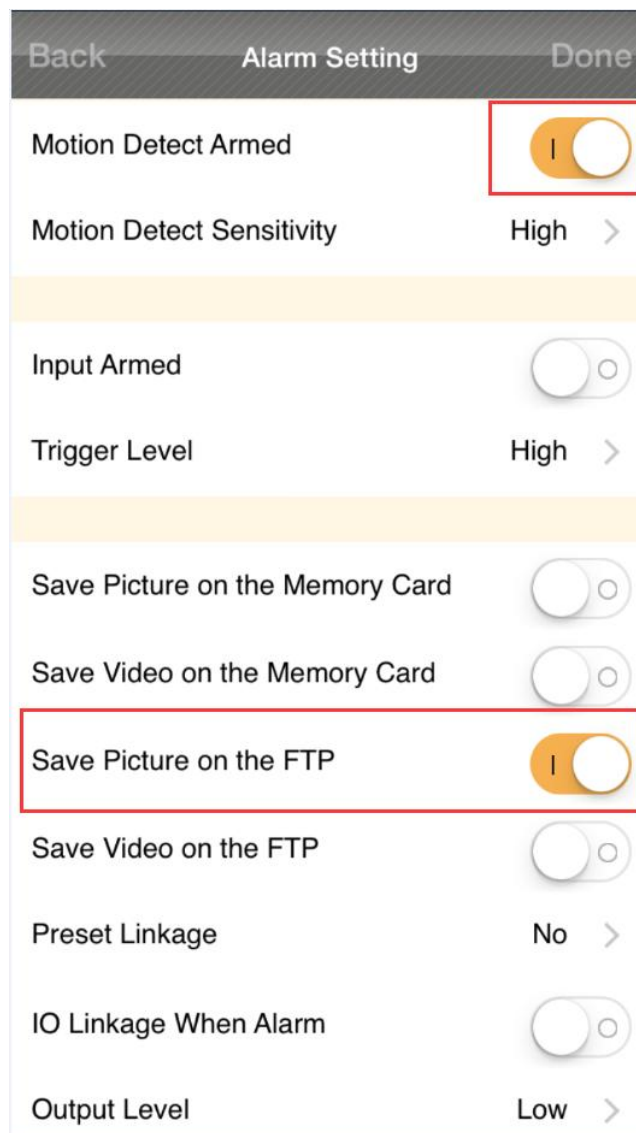
Directories: List / Create / Rename / Remove

Subdirectory: Inherit

Note: You could choose to save picture or video, only one once, not both of them.

Option 1 _Save Picture

Alarm Setting: Enable **[Motion Detect Armed]** & **[Save Picture on the FTP]**



FTP Setting: (Input your FTP server IP address, port, username, Password, Upload Path)

Please make sure all the information is correct.

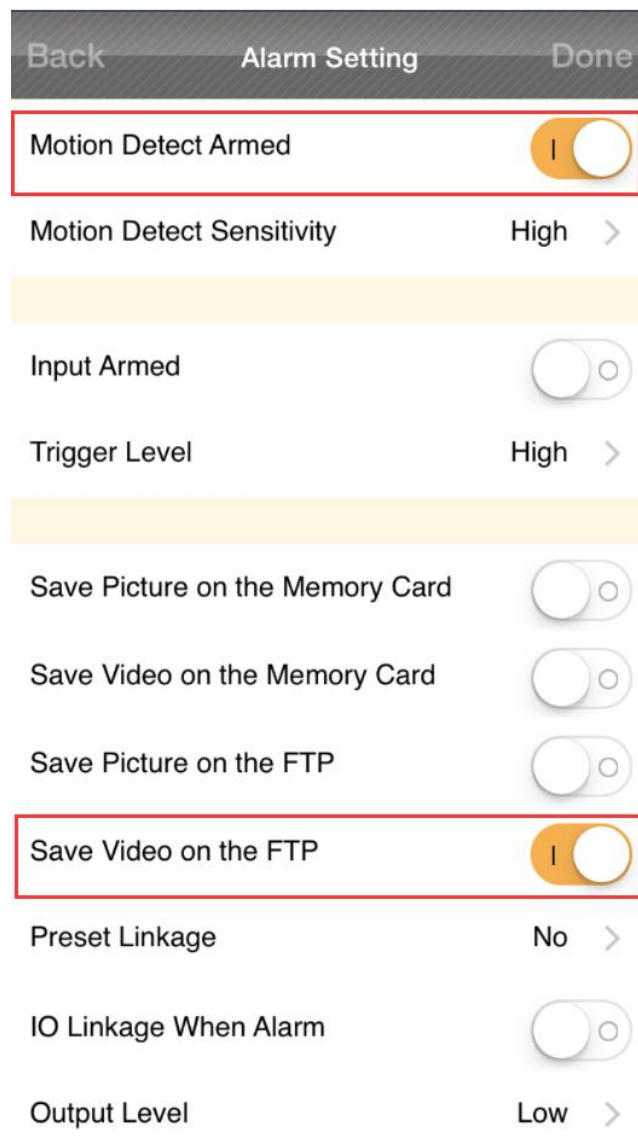
